

## Masai Mara Fly In – Fig Tree Camp

### DAY 1: NAIROBI – MASAI MARA

Guests will be collected early from their hotel and transferred to Wilson Airport for the scheduled flight to the Masai Mara. Upon arrival, you will be met by a guide from camp for a game drive en route to the camp. Following lunch, there will be an afternoon game drive returning to camp as the sun sets. If you arrive in the afternoon, then there will be a short game drive on the way to camp.

Lunch, dinner, bed & breakfast at your Masai Mara Camp (see below)

### DAY 2: MASAI MARA

Full day game viewing in the park. Rising at dawn with tea and coffee, then a game drive before breakfast, catching the animals before the heat of the day sets in. Then further game drives throughout the day before returning to the camp as the sun sets.

Lunch, dinner, bed & breakfast at your Masai Mara Camp (see below)

### DAY 3: MASAI MARA

Following breakfast and an early morning game drive pax will either return to Nairobi Wilson airport in the mid morning OR have lunch at the lodge/camp. Afterwards there will be a transfer back to the airstrip for the scheduled flight to Mombasa. Upon arrival, you will be met and transferred to your beach hotel where the safari ends.

### CAMP/LODGE DETAILS

#### **Fig Tree Camp**

Fig Tree Camp is located on the banks of the Talek River in the world famous Masai Mara National Reserve. The Camp is situated on the northern border of the reserve and its central location makes all areas of the park accessible during game drives. To make an evening a real adventure, at the Fig Tree Camp one can choose to stay in a tent or a cabin, giving the best of both worlds. The rooms spaciouly line up along the Talek River, overlooking the plains of the game reserve. 65 units comprise: 38 tents with twin beds and private balcony overlooking the Talek River and Mara game reserve. 22 cabins with double and single bed. 5 cabins with twin beds. All rooms are en suite and have their private balcony. The camp has several facilities and services to ensure you have a comfortable stay. These include two bars, a main dining room, an open-air dining area and tree house coffee deck. Also available is a video room, guest lecture facilities, swimming pool and curio shop. A fleet of four-wheel drive vehicles with expert drivers is available at the camp. The camp has a resident nurse and medical clinic. Power is supplied by generator from 4.00am to 9.00am, 12.00pm to 3.00pm, and from 6.00pm to 12.00am.

### **Child Rates**

- One child aged under 2 years free sharing with 2 adults
- One child aged 2-11 years sharing with 2 adults pays 75% of safari cost

### **Cost Includes**

- Meet and greet services
- On air safari packages game drives will be on a shared basis in camp/lodge 4x4 vehicles
- Meals and accommodation as specified
- All park fees and government taxes
- Flights as specified on the itinerary

- Visas, international flights and airport taxes (clients pay direct)
- Driver-guide gratuities, drinks, dining rooms tips and portage
- Personal travel, baggage and medical insurance
