

## 14-Day Delta and Kruger Park - ACS0401

### Day 1 Botswana - Ghanzi

Two per room L, D

An early morning as we leave Windhoek behind us and start off east towards the Buitepos border, were we then cross over into Botswana. Once at the lodge we'll get to meet with a local Bushmen community and see some traditional Tribal Dancing.

### Day 2/3/4 Botswana Maun - Okavango Delta

Two per room/permanent tent B,L,D

Another early day! Our journey takes us from Ghanzi towards Maun. We spend the night here in this gateway to the Okavango Delta preparing for our two nights bush experience. Your guides will provide you with a briefing about the next few days' activities, the environment and the community run tourism operation. From here in the morning we board small planes that transport us over the Delta to our destination. The flight is both practical and scenic. During our three days in the Delta we will go on a nature walk and if possible we will take mokoro (dugout canoes) rides with the local people.

### Day 5 Botswana - Gweta

Two per room B,L,D

After our scenic flight out, we leave the Delta behind us and travel east to Gweta. Gweta is located halfway between Maun and Nata, right next to the Makgadikgadi Pans National Park. The Makgadikgadi Pans National Park area was once a super lake almost 30 meters (100 feet) deep, over an area of 80,000 sq. km. When the climate changed 10,000 years ago Lake Makgadikgadi was well on the way to drying up. As the water evaporated, huge glistening salt-encrusted pans were left.

### Day 6 Botswana – Kasane - Chobe National Park

Two per room/permanent tent B,L,D

Leaving Gweta we head towards Kasane, where we stay on the banks of the Chobe River. The afternoon is spent Game viewing on a boat cruise, into the renowned Chobe NP. Viewing game from a boat is one of the most successful ways to see the animals in their own environment. You will also have the chance to experience an optional early morning game drive the next day.

### Day 7 Zimbabwe - Victoria Falls

Two per room B,L

Arriving early in Zimbabwe, we head off to visit the spectacular Victoria Falls and experience the thundering sound of the mighty Zambezi. The popular optional sunset cruise includes dinner and drinks. Optional Activities: Chobe Game Drive, Zambezi Sunset Cruise, dinner in local restaurant.

### **Day 8 Victoria Falls**

Two per Room B

Most people will spend the day white water rafting, a not-to-be-missed experience of a lifetime! Vic Falls offers many exciting alternatives. Optional Activities: White Water Rafting, Bungee Jump, Elephant Excursion and many more.

### **Day 9 Victoria Falls to Martinsdrift**

Two per Room No Meals

It is a long and uneventful drive through Botswana to the border at Martinsdrift where we will spend the night.

### **Day 10 Martinsdrift to Johannesburg,**

Two per Room No Meals

Another 6 am departure will ensure that we cover the next 750 km and get to Johannesburg as early as possible.

### **Day 11 Kruger National Park**

Two per Room L,D

Leaving behind Johannesburg, the city of gold, we head through the province of Mpumalanga to the world famous Kruger National Park. The next two days are spent exploring the southern part of this vast reserve and we stand a good chance of sighting elephant, lion, rhino, leopard and buffalo, Africa's famed "Big Five", on our game drives in the truck. Optional activities: Game drives and morning walk with park ranger.

### **Day 12 Kruger National Park**

Two per Room B,L,D

Our game drives continue and an early start usually rewards us with some great sightings. Keep your eyes open for the diverse bird life and some of the more elusive animals. An optional night drive with one of the South African National Park rangers is an excellent way to see some of the nocturnal animals. Optional activities: Game drives and morning walk with park ranger.

### **Day 13 Traditional Cultural Village - Timbavati**

Two per Room B,L,D

After a morning game drive in the truck or an optional game walk, we leave the Kruger NP and head for Timbavati. In the afternoon we visit a Shangaan village, and then make our way to a wildlife concession area adjacent to the KNP. This evening we experience an evening game drive. Tonight's game drive allows us another opportunity to view the mysterious nocturnal creatures that inhabit the African bushveld.



## Day 14 Panorama Route - JHB

We complete our Kruger Park experience with an early morning game walk before heading back towards Johannesburg. We will be traveling the Panorama Route through some spectacular scenery. Blyde River Canyon, the 3rd largest canyon in the world, offers breathtaking view points, including God's Window and three Rondavels. The Bourke's Luck Potholes are the fascinating results of erosion caused by the Treur River. Tour ends on arrival in Johannesburg.
