

14 Day Botswana Adventure

The Highlights

- * Travel through the Central Kalahari.
- * Guided Bushmen walk experience.
- * Game viewing in open 4x4 safari vehicle in Moremi Wildlife Reserve (4 days).
- * Mokoro (dugout canoe) excursion in the Okavango Delta area of Moremi.
- * Game viewing cruise on the Chobe River.
- * 2 nights in Livingstone/Victoria Falls.
- * Makgadikgadi Pans (weather dependant)

Day 1: **Johannesburg - Kalahari Desert**

We depart at 07h30 from our hotel in Johannesburg and travel through the Central Kalahari Desert. Overnight Nkisi Guesthouse (or similar).

(Accommodated — L, D)

Day 2: **Kalahari (Bushman Experience)**

We set up camp at a Bushmen village in the Kalahari. The project is owned and run by the local Bushmen community with all proceeds directly benefiting the community. A 1 hour guided bush walk is undertaken, with a local guide explaining and showing us the many uses of the surrounding environment.

(Camping — B, L, D)

Day 3/4: **Okavango Area of Moremi Wildlife Reserve**

We arrive in Maun by midday and enter Moremi Wildlife Reserve. We explore the area on early morning and late afternoon game drives in open 4x4 vehicles. Time is spent exploring the channels of the Okavango Delta by traditional mokoro.

(Camping — B, L, D)

Day 5/6: **Khwai Area of Moremi Wildlife Reserve**

The Khwai area is a pure wilderness area of great beauty, with rich green vegetation, palm trees, teeming with birdlife and a vast population of wild animals. We enjoy early morning and late afternoon game drives exploring the reserve in open 4x4 safari vehicles.

(Camping — B, L, D)

Day 7: **Moremi - Maun**

An early morning game drive is enjoyed as we leave Moremi, returning to Maun in time for lunch. We have the option of a scenic flight over the Okavango Delta (own expense). **(Camping — B, L, D)**



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Day 8/9: Chobe River - Kasane

Camp is set up on the banks of the Chobe River. Chobe is famous for its beautiful scenery, magnificent sunsets and abundance of wildlife and birdlife. An optional morning game drive is possible (own expense). Sunset is enjoyed on a relaxing game viewing boat cruise on the Chobe River.

(Camping — B, L, D)

Day 10/11: Livingstone/Victoria Falls "Mosi-oa-Tunya" - The Smoke that Thunders

We travel across the Zambian border to view Victoria Falls - one of the most spectacular sights in Africa. Days are spent at leisure to browse the local markets, to experience the many optional activities on offer in the adrenalin capital of Africa including white water rafting, bungi jumping, microlighting/airplane or helicopter flights over the Falls, rhino walks, elephant back safaris etc. and to visit the Falls (own expense).

(Camping — all meals excluding 1 lunch & 1 dinner)

Day 12: Nata

Crossing back into Botswana we travel South through Botswana. Late afternoon we visit Makgadikgadi Pans for an unforgettable sunset (weather dependant).

(Camping — B, L, D)

Day 13: Limpopo Area

Crossing the border into South Africa, we install our camp for the last night in the scenic Limpopo Province.

(Camping — B, L, D)

Day 14: Johannesburg

We travel via the 'Jacaranda City' of Pretoria, the administrative capital of South Africa and home of the famous Union Buildings, ending at +-16h00.
